



Changes with Progress Monitoring in IC

Differences from Exceed

Area	The Difference
Ending Plans	Plans in Exceed had to be ended, in IC they do not have to be ended. Once you reach the end date, you can no longer enter data.
Extending Plans	In Exceed you could continue to enter data after the end date, in IC you cannot enter data after the end date. You must decide to continue to provide the intervention and go on IC and change the end date, or create a new plan on IC.
Who can enter and see data?	In Exceed anyone at the school could enter data or see data. In IC only those Team Members you attach to a student as “Intervention Provider” can enter or see data.
Number of plans a student can have.	In Exceed a student could only have one behavior plan at a time. In IC a student can have multiple behavior plans going on at the same time. Every plan should be progress monitored with data, so if you are only collecting one data point for progress monitoring, you should only have one plan on IC (the highest intensity intervention)
Access to database	Exceed could only be accessed through the Apps page (on an MPS computer or using VPN). IC can be access under the Staff drop down on the MPS webpage- no VPN is needed.
Entering data points	On Exceed you just entered a score and an optional comment. On IC you must enter the time of the intervention and the score (a comment is still optional)
Templates	Exceed had templates, the user had to enter start date, end date, baseline, target, and intervention time. IC has templates, the user must enter start date, end date, base score, goal score, goal name, time of intervention, length of intervention, and frequency of intervention.
Locking a plan	On Exceed after creating a plan, data could be entered instantly. On IC you must Lock a plan in order to enter data (a plan can be unlocked at any time).
Deleting plans or scores	On Exceed a user could delete or adjust a plan or any score at any time. On IC a user can never delete a plan once created (user has to call Tech Support to have a plan deleted), a plan can always be adjusted. On IC a user can adjust or delete a score until 11:59 PM on the day of entry. After 11:59 PM all scores are locked in (user has to call Tech Support to have a score deleted)
Entering scores for multiple students	On Exceed a user could enter scores for individual students on one screen, or by multiple students on the same screen. On IC a user can enter scores for an individual student under Roster (in Campus Instruction) or Caseload (Under Index on Campus Tool). On IC a user can also enter scores for multiple students on Planner (in Campus Instruction).
Groups	On Exceed you could create a group and have all students have the same plan in the group. In IC at this time you cannot create a group and have all students have an intervention plan.
