

Robbins Infraction Definitions



Minor

Inappropriate Language: Disruptive language not suited for school use

Inappropriate Touching: Not keeping hands, feet, etc to oneself

Noncompliant: Not following directions as they are intended

Disruption: A disorderly outburst causing interruption

Property Misuse: Not handling school or someone's property in a protective way or as it is intended or allowed to be used. Cell phones must be turned off, kept in backpacks, and remain in lockers while school is in session.

Dress Code: Not following guidelines for respectful dress at school

Unexcused Tardy: Arriving to school after the morning bell without an acceptable excuse

Lying: Deliberate act of hiding or changing the truth

Cheating: Copying answers from someone else or using resources for answers when not approved by a staff member

Unsafe Behavior: Activity that could be harmful to oneself or others

Major

Profanity: Use of obscene or foul language including swearing and slurs

Physical Aggression: Intentional use of force against another including inappropriate contact and throwing of objects for the purpose of causing harm

Defiance: Intentionally ignoring a staff delivered directive or knowingly breaking a school rule after being redirected

Harassment: Verbal or cyber-related behavior intended to disturb, upset, embarrass, or harm someone else

Bullying: Extreme verbal behavior, cyber behavior, or any physical behavior set forth to intimidate a person to make them do something or make them feel uncomfortable

Truancy: Excessively missing school as determined by the truancy officer

Vandalism: Intentional and malicious destruction of the property of others causing financial loss

Stealing: Intentional taking of another person's property without that person's permission

Weapons: Possession of a knife, gun, ammunition or anything associated with causing harm towards another person

Third Minor: Student has received third minor
