The Wisconsin Student Immunization Law requires that all students through grade 12 must meet the minimum number of required immunizations prior to school entrance. These requirements can be waived only for health, religious, or personal conviction reasons. **Children in K5 through grade 5 who are not in compliance as of 10/14/19 will be excluded from school from 10/15/2019 through 10/18/2019** unless documentation of vaccination compliance is received at the school.

Our records show your child is not compliant because either (1) an immunization record is not on file at the school or (2) one or more immunization(s) have not been received (see reason for noncompliance marked below).

To avoid exclusion from school, please provide documentation from your doctor and/or health department with the month, day, and year that your child received the required immunization(s) or select one of the waiver options (See WI DPH Form F-04020L).

Under Wisconsin state law, the Milwaukee County District Attorney’s office is responsible for enforcement of the immunization law. Penalties for failure to immunize your child may include the following:

1. Submission of your name to the district attorney’s office for the purpose of considering whether to prosecute your violation of Wisconsin’s immunization law.
2. A decision to prosecute you could result in a forfeiture amount of \$25.00 for each day your child remains in noncompliance. Failure to pay this penalty may result in jail time.

In order to avoid any legal consequence, please get your child immunized. Please see the following table, which explains the vaccines your child must receive. **Your school expects to receive documentation from you regarding the following immunizations:**
