**ADDENDUM 3 TO RFP 1002:**  
**Extended Learning Opportunities Enrichment Partners**

**Amendment to RFP 1002**

Section 4.1 Communication/Questions of RFP 1002 is hereby deleted and replaced with the following language:

“The only permissible communication regarding this RFP with MPS staff, including any and all questions and requests for clarification, must be directed, in writing via email, to [mpsrfps@milwaukee.k12.wi.us](mailto:mpsrfps@milwaukee.k12.wi.us). The subject line of the email must be labeled “RFP 1002 - Question.” Any other communication to, or contact with, a MPS staff member regarding this RFP by respondent will be considered unauthorized and a cause for rejection of a respondent’s proposal.

As referenced in section 3.2 of the RFP, MPS will accept proposals for evaluation twice a year after the initial submission deadline. Those proposals must be submitted as indicated in Section 4.3, with the submission dates being September 1<sup>st</sup> and February 1<sup>st</sup> of the calendar year. Therefore, any such communications must be received by 2:00 p.m. Central Time, on August 15<sup>th</sup> and January 15<sup>th</sup> during each subsequent year after the initial submission deadline, or will be disregarded.

If a vendor has specific concerns regarding any aspect of the CCS process, including requirements, how requirements may be met or other, questions in writing may be submitted in writing directly to CCS at [505@milwaukee.k12.wi.us](mailto:505@milwaukee.k12.wi.us). However, the deadline for these questions remains the same. Any questions submitted to CCS must be received no later than 2:00 p.m. Central Time, on August 15<sup>th</sup> and January 15<sup>th</sup> during each subsequent year after the initial submission deadline, or will be disregarded

It is incumbent upon respondents to point out any possible discrepancies, omissions or ambiguities in the RFP using this question process. This includes alerting MPS that the RFP services or pricing requested are non-standard in the industry. By failing to do so, a respondent waives the right to claim any provision of this RFP is ambiguous.”
