Title I-A/Title IV-A/ESSER/GEER Technology **Agreement Terms**

To: Non-Public Schools

Our goal of preparing online learning opportunities is to provide options to reinforce academic skills, minimize instructional loss, and provide routines and structures to help students stay engaged and connected. These Title I-A/IV-A/ESSER/GEER devices remain the property of Milwaukee Public Schools district.

In allowing the Non-public schools to move Title I-A/IV-A/ESSER/GEER devices to the non-public school's server or network, the non-public schools must:

- Provide MPS (ESEA Department and Service Provider) admin/login access to each MPS technology device
- Not use Title I-A devices, they are only for the Title I-A classroom use
- Be take responsibility for Title I-A, IV-A, ESSER and GEER devices
 - School administrators will checkout Title IV-A, ESSER, GEER devices to families that need a device for virtual instruction
 - School administrators will have each family fill out a checkout form when a device is checked out and get the forms to the vendor when forms are completed
- Be responsible for the care and safekeeping of the MPS Technology device
- Keep technology in the locked carts when not in use
- Ensure all Title I-A/IV-A/ESSER/GEER technology devices are not used to access religious content
- Ensure all Title I-A/IV-A/ESSER/GEER technology devices and the Internet is used for educational purposes only
- Ensure students will not attempt to gain access or access any computer sites or files for which they do not have authorization
- Ensure all Title I-A/IV-A/ESSER/GEER technology devices have content filtering.
- Notify the (Service Provider) _____ at _____ immediately if any malfunction within the computer occurs, and not attempt to remedy any malfunction through their own efforts

In consideration of being given use of the MPS Technology device identified, I/we agree to forever release and discharge MPS ESEA Office and contracted service provider that delivers the ESEA service or its agents, employees, Board of School Directors, administrators, and volunteers, individually and collectively, from any claims, damages, or of action which may arise from student/staff use of the

technology. This includes claims relating to:

1. The content of any information or advice received by a student from a source outside of the school district or any costs that incurred as a result of seeking or accepting such advice;
2. Any harm resulting from the student/teacher accessing objectionable material over the Internet;
3. Any harm to the student/staff resulting from the student’s use of the Internet
4. Any costs, liability or damages caused by staff/student use of the computer, network, or Internet
5. Any consequences of service interruptions or changes whether or not they were under the control of the school district staff and /or the privacy of electronic mail
6. Information and Media Literacy - Accessing information efficiently and effectively, evaluating information critically and competently and understanding how media messages are constructed
7. Examining how individuals interpret messages differently, how values and points of view are included or excluded and how media can influence beliefs and behaviors
8. Possessing a fundamental understanding of the ethical/legal issues surrounding the access and use of information
