### **Title IA, IIA, IIIA, and IVA Non-public School Service Provider Selection for 2023-2024**

Milwaukee Public Schools serves as the administrative agency for federal Title funds that are available under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) to eligible Milwaukee students. In order to ensure that Title IA, IIA, IIIA and IVA services are provided to eligible private school students and personnel, the district needs to work cooperatively with participating non-public school officials. We appreciate your willingness to work with us to promote academic gains for Milwaukee resident students with the greatest educational needs. As a result of ongoing consultation with local non-public school officials, MPS employs a “third party vendor” model to provide Title services. The vendor provides services on behalf of MPS and provide continued, ongoing, timely, and meaningful consultations throughout the school year.

In October of 2019 2022, the district released a request for proposals (RFP) that led to the recommendation for the three vendors listed in the table below to provide an informational booth for nonpublic school official during the nonpublic vendor fair. Selection by a school to provide Title services may lead to the recommendation for approval of one or more of the vendors listed in the table below to provide Title IA, IIA, IIIA, and IVA services for eligible Non-public participants. Program descriptions for each of the recommended vendors may be found at the web address found in the header of this letter.

**If a school is currently receiving Title IA services from one of the service providers and if the school would like to continue that relationship or select a different vendor, please submit a selection form. All schools must participate in the district’s annual private school Title IA vendor selection process and complete this form out.**

To further assist you in this decision-making, a Non-public Schools Vendor Fair will be held on February 20, 21, and 22, 2024 via Sign-up Genius and Zoom. Each day one of the vendors will present from 9:00AM – 2:00PM. Click on the link to sign up with a vendor. Each vendor has a specific Zoom link for the Vendor Fair.

Please be reminded that the Vendor Selection Period is from February 14, 2024 – March 14, 2024. **All schools must submit a vendor selection form by the deadline date of March 14, 2024. If you do not send one in or select vendor by 4:00 PM on March 14, 2024, then a vendor will be assigned to you.**

**Title IA, IIA, IIIA, and IVA Non-public School Service Provider Selection for 2024-2025**

You may contact service providers directly for more information about their programs. You may also confer with other private school officials and parents for additional insight as you make a decision about the provider that can best meet your students’ needs within the limitations of the Title IA, Title IIA, Title IIIA, and/or Title IVA program.

In order to maintain a high ethical standard when determining a vendor to select, we require that participating school officials and school staff do not accept gratuities of any kind exceeding \$25 during the school year including meals, gifts and trips from a participating vendor.

Vendor school assignments must be as soon as possible so that plans can be made to hire staff in order to begin services promptly at the start of the 2024-2025 school year. Schools that do not respond within the identified time frame will be assigned to a vendor. Schools are only allowed to change service providers during the annual selection period. After a vendor is selected each school will be contacted by its provider to arrange details of service delivery. Should you have any questions, please contact the service providers or the MPS ESEA Department.

It is of utmost importance that each school’s administrator, staff, families and students, where appropriate, engage in a rigorous, inclusive and thoughtful vendor selection process.
