Job Summary

Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) is a research-based systems approach for supporting the behavioral needs of all students. PBIS is a school-wide framework designed to enhance the capacity of schools to effectively educate all students, with the goal of adopting, expanding and sustaining the use of evidenced based practices. Each coach is responsible for guiding PBIS and Building Intervention Team meetings, conversations, and activities at all assigned schools. The coach meets regularly with school staff to train, facilitate procedures, model effective student interventions and consult on the implementation process.

Qualifications

- A minimum of three (3) years successful experience as a teacher
- Experience with schools PBIS Tier 1 Team or Building Intervention Team (BIT) member

Responsibilities

- Supports PBIS Tier 1 and Building Intervention Team meetings
- Provides ongoing technical support and training
- Acts as a liaison with district departments,
- Assists in and complete data collection and analysis with schools
- Supports OCR Resolution requirements and data collection
- Supports District Climate Improvement Plan
- Guides annual planning at schools
- Helps schools view PBIS as a tiered system of support working with other district initiatives
- Commits to ongoing professional development in the areas related to PBIS, trauma sensitive schools, restorative practices, mindfulness, and other approaches within the PBIS framework
- Visits and supports teachers and staff members in behavioral and academic supports in the classroom
- Ensures the integrity and fidelity of implementation of PBIS
- Attends and facilitates after school training opportunities
- Actively supports the MPS Strategic Plan
- Completes other duties as assigned
