

### Quarterly Review and Updates to Calendar Plan

<b>S</b>	<b>STUDY: To be completed quarterly and at end of school year</b>	
<b>Summarize Data to Date</b>	<p>During October, the committee finalized the calendar survey. There were 11,031 family, staff, and students who participated in the survey. The results indicate a preference for the traditional calendar with a September start date.</p> <p>The single calendar was developed and presented to the Milwaukee Board of School Directors in December. The calendar was approved.</p> <p>After approval, there were several communications to families and staff that included a web story, email, and social media posts.</p>

	<p><b>What will you change about your plan for the next quarter?</b></p> <p>The implementation of the communications plan needs to be extended now and at the end of the school year. The action plan has been adjusted for the time needed to be thorough in our communications.</p> <p>Offices are working to adjust work for a single calendar. For example, special programs are being developed for Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate students. These programs will provide additional preparation for students planning on program assessments in the spring of 2025. Another example is that payroll calendars are being developed for a single school calendar. Professional development calendars are being adjusted to the single calendar. Staff codes are being adjusted for the single calendar as well.</p>
