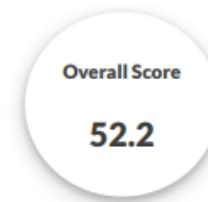

Vision and Values

School Improvement Goals and Strategies

Goals 1 and 2: Our school will increase the percent of students who score proficient math and English language arts on the state assessments year after year.

Strategy: Create, implement, and monitor an instructional plan to address reading, writing, and math and strategies throughout the 2021-22 school year.

Supply staff with ongoing support through coaching, mentoring, observations and feedback.

Provide a system of academic intervention to ensure that all students are moving towards proficiency and making progress in meeting grade level expectations.

Goal 3: Our school will increase the percentage of students graduating in four years. *(for High Schools only)*

Goal 4: Our school will attain a test participation rate of 95% or higher.

Strategy: Provide strategies to improve engagement throughout the year.
