#### School Improvement Goals and Strategies

##### Vision:

Barack Obama School of Career and Technical Education aims to develop students from early childhood through high school, graduating students with a 360 degree education which encompasses a Technical Education background as well as strong college and career readiness skills to build their confidence to advocate for themselves and their communities.

##### Values:

The staff at Barack Obama School of Career and Technical Education believe that all students can achieve. We are dedicated to providing an academic environment that ensures student success. To this end we are committed to:

1. Working collaboratively together as a professional learning community to develop culturally responsive educators who will successfully implement restorative practices in challenging academic classrooms.
2. Making data-driven decisions to implement instructional programs that develop the whole child, intellectually and academically, personally, and socially, physically, emotionally, and ethically.
3. Establishing partnerships with the home and community to ensure a successful transition from grade bands to graduation.

##### District Key Metrics

1. Schools will demonstrate a 5% increase in the number of students who score proficient in math and English language arts (overall and disaggregated by groups) on the state assessments from the spring of 2021-22 to the spring of 2023-24.
2. Schools will demonstrate a 10% decrease in the number of students who score below basic in math and English language arts (overall and disaggregated by groups) on the state assessments from the spring of 2021-22 to the spring of 2023-24.
3. Schools will increase the percentage of students (overall and disaggregated by groups) graduating by 10% as measured by the four-year graduation rate in WISEdash.
4. Schools will maintain a 95% attendance rate.
5. Schools will have 100% of students regularly attending (90% of the time).
6. Schools will reduce the racial/ethnic disproportionality in referrals, identifications and disciplinary procedures through the use of equitable practices as part of a multi-tiered system of support.

**ACCELERATING LEARNING GOAL:** Every student will reach academic excellence/proficiency at every grade level and graduate on time ready to meet their future success.

**Academic Theory of Action:** If we as a staff implement the RACE (Restate, Answer Questions, Cite Evidence, Explain) strategy, then we will see improved student skills in writing in the content area, which will lead to higher proficiency rates in writing.

**CULTIVATING EQUITABLE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT GOAL:** Every student will thrive as a result of a positive school climate and culture in which all students are supported, valued and respected.

**Culture/Climate Theory of Action:** If we do consistent professional development with our staff on building community, then we'll see teachers developing relationships with staff and students, which will lead to a sense of belonging and community to the classrooms and school.
