## School Description

Bay View High School provides a comprehensive 9th–12th grade education focused on the arts (including culinary arts), design, and engineering. Using a STEAM focus supports the philosophy of project-based learning, which builds student knowledge across multiple academic disciplines. In addition, Bay View sets rigorous expectations for graduation. Students have access to a math and ELA Springboard curriculum, honors, and Advanced Placement (AP) courses. In addition, students can earn special graduation recognition in the areas of visual art, culinary art, design and engineering.


### Points of School Pride

- We are extremely proud of the launch our new culinary arts program in 2016-17.
- We are pleased with the growth of our NAF Academy of engineering (PLTW), including the Formula 1 Race Car project, the longboard project and the robotics competition.
- 80 percent of our classroom teachers use our maker’s space for integrated project-based learning, infusing art into the core subject areas.
- We have increased the use restorative practices school wide, improving school climate (suspensions are down 7.6 percent from last year).
