School Description

We serve students from K4 through 8th grade in Milwaukee’s south side Silver City neighborhood a few blocks from the Mitchell Park domes. The school is named after MPS’ first woman principal, Anna F. Doerfler and was originally Scott Street School. We value our culturally diverse population of Latino, African American, White, Asian American and Native American students. We support our large Spanish-speaking population with a Bilingual Program for grades K4-5th. Doerfler benefits from the Achievement Gap Reduction (AGR) program which allows us to keep K5 class sizes at an 18:1 student-to-teacher ratio and provide extra supports for teaching and learning in the elementary grades. Doerfler’s vision is to become a safe and united community of lifelong learners. Doerfler values respectful and positive relationships, growth mindset, social and emotional learning, equity, collaboration, family and community partnerships, rigor, differentiation, inquiry/project-based learning, and cultural relevance.
