School Description

Milwaukee French Immersion School provides English speaking students an opportunity to learn French in an environment where French is the primary language of instruction. Students learn to read and write in both French and English. 5th grade students participate in a capstone experience where they are immersed in French culture and language for one week at Concordia Language Villages. New students are accepted in K4, K5, and 1st grade. Prior French language instruction is needed to enter in 2nd-5th.
