Milwaukee German Immersion School provides English-speaking pupils the opportunity to learn German in a school where German is the primary language of instruction. Children receive reading instruction in English beginning in second grade. Milwaukee German Immersion has won countless honors through the years, including the prestigious Melba D. Woodruff Award from ACTFL (American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages) in 2014. This award is given to only one school in the United States every year. New students are accepted only in kindergarten and first grade.
