
Points of School Pride

- Named a WI DPI PBIS School of Distinction for Mathematics, and a WI DPI PBIS School of Merit for Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports.
- Added a new academic support program for all K-5 students through our daily W.I.N. (What I Need) program where students receive specialized academic support in reading and mathematics through computer based instructional programs and small group teacher led explicit instruction based on student STAR data.
- Our older students read with younger students through our Book Buddies program.
- Students participate in frequent field trips to the Urban Ecology Center receiving educational experiences outside of the classroom around science education.

School Programs

Innovative approaches to literacy, early childhood education, urban agriculture/aquaponics, before and after school child care through our camp program, neighborhood association partnerships, Parent Teacher Organization, parent resource center, music, art and full time physical education, environmental science, after school athletics / sports (i.e., intramurals), competitive athletics / sports, recreation enrichment, sports, student governance council, college and university partnerships, mentoring partnerships, other student development, Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS), and Response to Intervention (RtI).
