
### Points of School Pride

- School Report Card increased by 17.1 percent, increasing from 45.4 to 62.5.
- Partnerships with the Hilton Milwaukee City Center Hotel and Trilogy Insurance include tutoring, job shadowing for our 5th graders, student and parent incentives.
- Added a violin program for our K4 students updates to our school library and the purchase of multicultural books for our classroom libraries.
- On a weekly basis, Kagel parents receive computer classes and English as a Second Language classes.
