Our school benefits from the Achievement Gap Reduction (AGR) Program. Our mobile laptop labs, iPads and smart boards ensure that Kluge students are connected to the technology they will need to succeed. Kluge offers its students full-time specialist-taught art and music classes along with additional arts activities thanks to grants and our community partners such as Danceworks, Johnson Controls and Sharp Literacy. We also partner with First Stage for Literacy Through the Arts programming during our school day as well as our after school CLC program. We partner with RSVP to bring tutoring into many of our classrooms. Kluge also offers an English as a Second Language (ESL) program and extensive services for medically fragile students.


Points of School Pride

- Partnering with Johnson Controls, our 5th grade students participate in A World in Motion demonstrating team work while designing and engineering cars out of recyclable materials.
- Partnering with First Stage Theater, students participate with First Stage Artists during the school day with the Literacy through the Arts programs. The seven-week lessons culminate in each classroom attending a performance related to their previous research and study in the classroom.
- Partnered with My Very Own Library to enhance students' love of reading and to build their own libraries at home by providing 10 free books to each student during the school year.
- Named a WI DPI School of Distinction in the areas of Reading, Math and PBIS.
