Gym classes, Spanish curriculum available for all grades, Children's Hospital services on site, school uniforms, transportation, after school programs through Community Learning Center (CLC), and a host of other programs aimed to support student growth and development are available. LaFollette is a true school family focused on students, their families and staff.


Points of School Pride

- Strong Early Childhood Unit, in grades K4 and K5, where the focus is hands-on learning while creating a safe place for learning where students are engaged and view learning as fun.
- “All-day” Head Start K3 added to our school in the Fall of 2017.
- Through a partnership with America Scores-Milwaukee LaFollette will receive a soccer field built on our playground.
- Engaged in a pilot program where 8th grade students, upon graduation, will have earned a semester credit in Spanish prior to entering high school.

Achievement Gap Reduction (AGR), Community Learning Center (CLC) through the Boys and Girls Club of Greater Milwaukee, health initiatives through Children's Hospital and coordinated school health, multi-age classrooms, Head Start , after school athletics, PBIS (positive behavioral interventions and supports), RTI (Response to Interventions), extended learning opportunities/Teaching for You (T4U), nutrition education with our fresh fruits and vegetable program.
