Milwaukee School of Languages (MSL), named among the 15 best high schools in Wisconsin in 2015 by U.S. News & World Report, offers language immersion programs in German, French and Spanish. MPS elementary language immersion graduates enter our full immersion program in Grade 6. Students continue their second language studies until graduation. This unique program produces advanced levels of foreign language proficiency, translating into advanced standing in college. Art, music and physical education classes are offered at all grade levels as well as other elective classes. Students have the opportunity to participate in the AP Capstone Program as well as take Advanced Placement courses in 11 subjects.
