Barack Obama School of Career and Technical Education, located in the former Custer High School building, serves students in a small school setting aimed at high achievement in reading, writing and math. We offer students a project-based, career-centered and partner-supported education. Our HVAC lab operates with the assistance of our partners at Milwaukee Area Technical College (MATC). Our new advanced manufacturing lab offers students access to state-of-the-art Computer Numerical Control (CNC) equipment and computer-integrated manufacturing technology. We match our students to an appropriate career cluster: advanced manufacturing or energy conservation. Obama SCTE also has robotics, welding, wood shop and barber/cosmetology labs. Obama SCTE offers credit recovery and GEDO2 in a personalized blended learning lab on campus.


Points of School Pride
