School Description

Project STAY Alternative High School is a small high school located in the downtown area of Milwaukee. This program offers a nurturing and challenging education to 250 high school students, ages 16-20, who are at risk of dropping out of a traditional high school. Parents & students are welcome to apply in person and participate in the orientation process once accepted to the school. To be enrolled, students must follow school rules, maintain 90% attendance and complete the at-risk requirement. While in school, students prepare for high school completion and enrollment in a post secondary school. We offer students the opportunity to participate in a diploma plus program, partnering with an outside agency to earn other certifications while still attending high school. Students will need to petition the school to participate in the diploma plus program. Teen parents at Project S.T.A.Y. will be able to bring their child to school while they attend high school. We make a difference in the life of a student contemplating dropping out of high school.


Points of School Pride
