



**CONTRACT COMPLIANCE SERVICES**

**Accepted Certification Agencies**

- **DBE** **Disadvantaged Business Enterprise.** A certified “for-profit” business entity which has proven it is at least 51% owned and controlled by one or more individuals who are both socially and economically disadvantaged.
- **HUB Zone** **Hubzone Program:** It must be a small business by SBA standards. It must be owned and controlled at least 51% by U.S. Citizens, a Community Development Corporation, an agricultural cooperative, or an Indian tribe.
- **MBE** **Minority Business Enterprise.** A certified “for-profit” business entity which has proven it is at least 51% owned and controlled by minority group members.
- **NMSDC** **North Central Minority Supplier Development Council.** A “for-profit” enterprise located in the United States or its trust territories. A business must be 51% ethnic minority owned defined as African-American, Hispanic-American, Native American, Asian and Pacific Islander (Asian-Indian included). Minority/ethnic owner(s) of the business must be U.S. citizens. The minority/ethnic business owner(s) must be active in the management and the daily business operations.
- **SBA-8A** **Small Business Administration – 8A.** A “for-profit” small business that has been certified by the Small Business Administration
- **SBE** **Small Business Enterprise.** A certified “for-profit” business entity which has proven it is at least 51% owned and controlled by one or more individuals who are both socially and economically disadvantaged.
- **SDVOSBC** **Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Business Concerns:** The Service Disabled Veteran (SDV) must have a service-connected disability that has been determined by the Department of Veterans Affairs or Department of Defense. The SDVOSBC must be small under the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) code assigned to the procurement. The SDV must unconditionally own 51% of the SDVOSBC. The SDVO must control the management and daily operations of the SDVOSBC. The SDV must hold the highest officer position in the SDVOSBC
- **WBE** **Women’s Business Enterprise.** A certified “for-profit” business entity which has proven it is at least 51% owned and controlled by women.
- **WOSB** **Women Owned Small Business:** A business must be at least 51% owned and controlled by one or more women and primarily managed by one or more women who are deemed economically disadvantaged.
